

**The Town Council of the Town of Smithfield desires to amend, by Ordinance Chapter 340, Article IV of the Town of Smithfield Code of Ordinances entitled “Schedule of Penalties” by amending thereto Section 340-15(a) entitled “Nonmoving Violations” and adding Section 340-15(c) entitled “Temporary No Parking Regulations”.**

**IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SMITHFIELD AS FOLLOWS:**

**§340-15 Schedule of violation penalties.**

The following schedule of violation penalties is hereby adopted:

**A. Nonmoving violations.**

<u>Violation</u>	<u>Fine</u>
Overtime parking	\$50.00
Parking in prohibited area	\$50.00
Parking within 8 feet of a fire hydrant	\$50.00
Parking in loading zone	\$50.00
Parking with left wheels to curb	\$50.00
Angle parking	\$50.00
Double parking or parking in excess of 3 feet from curb	\$50.00
Parking within 25 feet of corner	\$50.00
Parking to obstruct driveway	\$50.00
Parking on sidewalk	\$50.00
Stopping or standing during prohibited hours	\$50.00
Parallel parking or parking in excess of 1 foot from curb	\$50.00
Parking in crosswalk	\$75.00
Parking within intersection	\$75.00
Overnight parking and abandoned vehicles in posted areas	\$50.00
Snow emergency	\$75.00
Unattended vehicle on public highway	\$75.00
Parking in fire lane	\$75.00
Handicap parking	\$100.00
Temporary No Parking	\$50.00


**B. Moving violations.** The schedule of violations as defined in G.L. 1956, Title 31, Chapter 41, entitled "Administrative Payment of Certain Traffic Offenses," and other references to moving traffic violations within Title 31 of the General Laws are hereby incorporated by reference and made a part of this section.

**C. Temporary No Parking Regulations**

The Town Manager or their designee is hereby empowered to declare a temporary parking ban for such periods of time that shall last no longer than seven (7) days. The Town Manager or their designee shall take all reasonable steps to post and convey the parking ban to the residents of the Town by posting on the Town website 48 hours prior to the event. Any police officer may remove or cause to be removed any vehicle left on the public highways of the Town in violation of §340-13 to some designated place where it shall be surrendered to its owner upon payment of any authorized charges. If any such vehicle is unregistered it may be disposed of in any manner deemed reasonable by the Police Department.

Section 2. This ordinance shall take effect thirty (30) days after its adoption


