

**AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 118 OF THE TOWN OF SMITHFIELD  
CODE OF ORDINANCE ENTITLED "ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES."**

§ 118-8 Beach areas.[1]

No person shall possess or consume any alcoholic or tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) containing beverage on any of the beaches operated by the Town or public areas adjacent thereto.

§ 118-9 Public property.

No person, whether in or outside a motor vehicle, shall consume any alcoholic or tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) containing beverages on any public street, sidewalk or parking lot in Town, nor on any property owned by the Town of Smithfield.[1]



§ 118-10 Business property.


It shall be unlawful for any person to consume alcoholic or tetrahydrocannabinol (THC) containing beverages in public view on private property on which a business is conducted, where the owner of such property has posted a prohibition against such consumption and where such notice has been filed with the Chief of Police.


These ordinance amendments shall take effect thirty (30) days after their adoption.
